I EXPLANATION

The attached appendices indicate numerous production statistics of the German Iron and Steel Industry. Several pertinent facts are brought out in these charts:

1. Steel production in the later years of the war approximated 30 million tons per year. The production of Czechoslovakia is included in that total.
2. It is evident that steel production in the occupied territories, including Italy, averaged between 4 to 5 million tons per year. This amount is far below the normal total peace time capacity of Poland, Belgium, France, the Netherlands, Luxembourg, and Italy. It must be concluded that the Reich either did not operate the total potential producing capacity, or there was a definite and successful slow-down policy in these areas.
3. Pig iron production averaged 23 million to 24 million tons per year in Germany including Czechoslovakia.
4. Pig iron production in the occupied areas, including Italy, approximated 3,500,000 tons to 3,800,000 tons annually. Again the total productive capacity was well below the normal peace time production.
5. Appendix "C" gives statistics on the total production of finished rolled steel products.
6. Appendix "D" indicates the tonnage used in May 1944 in the forging industry.
